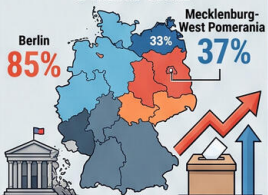

DAY-AT-A-GLANCE

September 20, 2026, was defined by a critical escalation in the Middle East as Houthi forces launched **strategic strikes** against Saudi Arabian oil infrastructure, specifically targeting the [Yanbu oil port](#). This provocation forced U.S. President Donald Trump to abort a retreat at Camp David and return to the White House for **emergency consultations** regarding potential retaliatory measures against Yemen and its backers in [Tehran](#).
